Delicate fragrance of white peaches, apricot and juicy pears. The classic Riesling in expression and elegance.

Frangy is one of four named crus of the Roussette de Savoie appellation and region in far eastern France. Dry, rich and mineral, the wine delivers fragrances of bergamot, almond and apple. A lively palate of fresh lemon zest, stonefruits and a hint of hazelnut.

An aromatic nose, a touch of mint. On the palate, grapey with some honeysuckle and orange blossom. Not bone dry, but still crisp and delicate.

Navaherreros Blanco, Bernabeleva - Castilla y Leon, Spain 2009(Organic)

Classic pale Provençale rose, almost transparent with fine floral notes of jasmine and wild rose, fresh red berry fruit with a note of wild, soft seductive richness and off dry mouth feel.

Château Virecourt « Alexandre » (%100 Merlot) - Bordeaux, France 2007

A beautiful deep purple and the nose is particularly complex with intense aromas recalling of baked plum. On the palate, the wine is smooth and beautifully dense.

Cabernet Sauvignon «Whole Berry», Springfield Estate - Robertson, South Africa.2010

Well-structured new world Cabernet soft, rich, with warming sweet mid palate, velvety tannins to round off.

Lard des Choix VdT, Les Champs Libres - Ardeche, France 2010(Organic)

A blend of Syrah and Gamay, red and dark cherry aromas on the nose with hints of spice. Fruity yet earthy on a lively and fresh palate. The feel is juicy and spicy with a good tannic structure.

Nebbiolo «Perbacco», Vietti - Piemonte, Italy 2008

Moderately deep medium red. Lovely earthy perfume of cherry, leather, smoke, rose petal and minerals, with an exotic whiff of peach. At once sweet and bright, with vibrant acidity giving shape and precision to the dense earth, saline and floral flavours. Finishes with firm tannins, lovely lift and verve, and noteworthy length.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape « Les Olivets », Domaine Roger Sabon - Southern Rhône, France 2008

Smoky roasted meat character, black cherries and kirsch, pepper, herbs (bayleaf, rosemary) glycerin fruit. Rich, deep and generous, with a compelling sweetness of fruit and a lush, pliant texture.

A Selection of Organic, Biodynamic & Natural Wines

These wines are made from organically or biodynamically farmed grapes from vineyards where biodiversity is respected and fermented on the wild yeasts and finally bottled with minimum filtration, fining or addition of sulphur. The intention is to express the "terroir" or provenance of the wine, the individuality of the vine in its particular location and the nature of the vintage itself. These wines, with their purity, freshness and undoubted minerality, have a wonderful affinity for food.

Whites

- Verdicchio di Matelica, Colle Stefano - Marche, Italy 2010 £29.00
A crisp, light white with beautiful citrus fruit. First a thwack of lime and then minerals all the way.
- Afros Vinho Verde Loureiro Branco - Lima, Portugal 2010 £35.00
A biodynamic gem from northern Portugal. Beautifully smoky, slightly mineral quality, with that ripe, pure lemon zest and bold pear-skin fruit.
- Jurançon Sec « Vitatge Vielh », Clos Lapeyre - South West France 2006 £48.00
Extraordinary blend of Gros Manseng, Petit Manseng and Courbu. Golden colour, marzipan and sugared pink grapefruit on the nose, thoroughly exotic hints of coconut and mango in the mouth with brilliant, bracing pineapple-flecked acidity.
- Riesling K, Domaine Audrey & Christian Binner - Alsace, France 2007 £59.00
A medium straw colour. Unsurprisingly for an unfiltered wine, it is also slightly cloudy. The nose is very earthy and rich with notes of green fruits and petrol. The minerality also shines through. On the palate, dry and refreshing with pleasantly tart citrus flavours and excellent acidity. Notes of pepper and elderflower.
- Bourgogne Blanc « Bigotes », Dmne de Chassorney - Burgundy, France 2007 £62.00
The palate is virtually sliced with a lemony snickersnee of acidity and the merest flicker of vanilla and toasted nut highlights rather than contrasts the edginess of the wine.
- Bianco, Le Coste de Gradoli - Lazio, Italy 2008 £72.00
A bone dry expression of the Precanico grape, on the palate some zingy apple, a touch of fresh almond and confit lemon with hints of cinnamon, a middle-weight wine with a rich structure.

Reds

- Saint-Nicolas de Bourgueil « Hurluberlu », Dmne S.David - Loire, France 2009 £40.00
100% Cabernet Franc bursting with red fruit vitality. A versatile food wine and happy to be served chilled.
- Cheverny « Rouillon », Clos du Tue-Bœuf - Loire, France 2010 £43.00
Delightful blend of Gamay and Pinot Noir. Unfiltered, unfinned and unsulphured, pure as the driven wine.
- Pinot Noir, Domaine Pierre Frick - Alsace, France 2008 £55.00
It has all the delicacy you would expect of pinot with a seam of earthy spice which saves it from being wishy washy, utterly fresh and fabulous.
- Zinfandel « Juvenile », Turley Winery - Napa Valley, USA 2009 £57.00
Un-fined, unfiltered bad boy, big cherries, vanilla, liquorice. Pick an adjective, it is in there under the alcohol.
- Arbois « Pupillin », Maison Pierre Overnoy 2009 - Jura, France 2009 £68.00
Very pale and cloudy. Floral nose, especially roses. Very light-weight and feminine wine. Fresh, a little cherry syrupy sweet but not cloying. Friendly, juicy with very subtle tannins and a wine for clean tasting food. This wine needs serious breathing, don't be fooled by the first sip.
- Faugères « La Valiniere », Dmne Leon Barral - Languedoc-Roussillon, France 2006 £70.00
A blend of Mourvedre and Syrah grown in the district of Faugeres. Strong dark fruits, warm leather, dark chocolate, fine floral notes, black olives and oriental spices. Dense and powerful.
- Rosso Piu, le Coste di Gradoli - Lazio, Italy 2008 £83.00
Reductive on the nose, but once decanted it reveals a silky and soft structure carrying
Some concentrated wild berries, elegance is last word coming to your mind as
you finish sipping it.

Whites

1990 Riesling St Urbans-Hof Ockfener Bockstein Auslese - Mosel, Germany £122.00
A drizzle of kerosene, subtle citrus, tropical fruits, mineral edge on the nose. Off-dry, the sugar is perfectly balanced with the acidity. In the mouth, drops of honey dripped over bits of pear and nectarine, some osmanthus aromas and a little touch of Peach Melba at the background.

1988 Gewurztraminer Cuvee des Seigneurs de Ribeaupierre, Dmne Trimbach- Alsace, France £135.00
An utterly profound wine, deeply extracted, golden coloured. An effusively floral nose with a honeyed richness on the palate and a smashing long finish.

2007 Corton-Charlemagne, Domaine Dublere - Burgundy, France £190.00
Grand cru Burgundy with powerful buttery fruit buttressed by notes of toasted hazelnuts washed clean by lacy lemony acidity.

1997 Batard-Montrachet, Domaine Ramonet - Burgundy, France £350.00
Complex with layers of spice, smoke, toast, honey and tobacco, fine citrus fruits and lingering flavours of cedar and clove, all beautifully harmonised.

2001 Hermitage, Domaine Jean-Louis Chave - Northern Rhone, France £195.00
This White Hermitage exhibits a diverse bouquet of acacia, honeysuckle and apricots, supported by a palate of vanilla, grilled almonds and minerals.

2009 Chateau Larrivet-Haut-Brion - Pessac-Leognan, Bordeaux £ 110.00
Ripe and round in an attractively fruity style. Citrus-apple aromas and flavours. Oak is present but integrated. A powerful wine with an elegant finish.

1997 Marche Bianco, Fattoria San Lorenzo - Marche, Central Italy(Biodynamic) £109.00
This astonishing biodynamic wine made from Verdicchio is aged in vats for several years before release. Complex flavours of roast apricots with secondary notes of herbs and ginger and terrific minerality.

2009 Cervaro Della Sala, Antinori - Umbria, Italy £120.00
A complex array of flavours, including citrus, pear, acacia and vanilla show on the nose. It is rich and full bodied on the palate with butter, hazelnut and mineral showing through the ripe and lengthy fruit.

2003 Chateau Musar - Bekaa Valley, Lebanon(Organic) £70.00
A blend of Obaideh and Merwah, straw gold in appearance, displaying aromas of orange peel, sweet spice and stewed pears. The palate is rich and generous with crisp citrus, a touch of almond.

Reds

1999 Cabernet Sauvignon, Chateau Montelena - Napa Valley, California £181.00
Stunning balance between ripe tannins and some big fruit flavours followed with some leathery aromas, with black cherry, a hint of spice and a whiff of smokiness.

2004 Shiraz The Struie, Torbreck - South Australia £120.00
Using grapes from the Barossa Valley and the Eden Valley, this wine delivers a floral hit of violets, then makes its way with the more brooding aromas of tar, chocolate, liquorice and coffee with a subtle hint of cinnamon and spice.

- 1985 Barolo Borgogno Riserva - Piemonte, Italy £260.00
This wine has a bouquet layered with notes of light aged wood, dried fruits, and flowers. Full-bodied with the warmth of alcohol, it is intense, yet mellow, full and round on the palate.
- 2003 Brunello di Montalcino Riserva, Gianfranco Soldera - Tuscany, Italy(Organic) £385.00
Surprisingly supple and open at this stage. Texturally silky and refined, the 2003 Riserva shows wonderful balance in its aromas and flavours, shows a brilliant colour, correspondingly \fresher flavours.
- 1999 Sassicaia, San Guido - Tuscany, Italy £350.00
The nose is wonderfully expressive, with dried roses, black fruit, leather and vanilla. Tannins are silky, a velvety, filling yet elegant mouth feel and a smooth, medium long finish.
- 2005 Gevrey-Chambertin Les Seuvrees, Domaine Lignier - Burgundy, France £93.00
Ruby red colour, subtle on the nose. Well-balanced and subtle black pepper, dark earth, grapejuice.
This wine is reaching it full peak of maturity.
- 1995 Chambolle-Musigny 1er Cru Amoureuuses, Dmne Roumier - Burgundy, France £1100.00
A ruby core with an amber rim. Delectably ripe and fragrant on the nose, with mango chutney and spicy notes. Finely balanced on the palate, with excellent ripe fruit and already a delight to drink. Mouth coating and spicy on the finish.
- 2001 Hermitage, Domaine Jean Louis Chave - Northern Rhône, France £270.00
This wine if full of aromas of Black fruits, leather, game and spices, all layered over a fine structure of tannins that soften and sweeten with age.
- 1998 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Château de Beaucastel - Southern Rhône, France £120.00
Intensely refined chocolate and leather flavours abound, growing in intensity as the wine breaths.
- 1990 Château Chasse-Spleen, Moulis-en-Médoc - Bordeaux, France £220.00
Subtle cherry flavours and hints of plum coming along, a gentle minerality and some cedar wood to round it all up.
- 1982 Vieux Château Certan, Pomerol - Bordeaux, France £502.00
Aromas of dried red fruit, chocolate, cigar box, herbs and earth. Full-bodied with a rather lush and velvety smooth mouth feel on the palate with nicely integrated tannins and medium acidity with flavours of plum tart, smoke and earth. Good length with a chocolaty earthy finish.
